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ADDITIONAL ITEMS

Class	Shoes	Clothes	Color
Jazz	Slip on or lace up jazz shoes	Leggings, shorts, or jazz pants with class leotard	Black
Modern	No shoes, dance paws if necessary	Convertible tights or leggings with class leotard or shirt	Black
Variations	Pointe	Ladies may wear a solid color wrap skirt for Variations	Solid

HAIR

A student's hair for ballet class is just as important as the leotard and tights that a dancer wears. Proper hair in class is part of a student's uniform and should be done every day for class, rehearsals, and performances.

LADIES: hair should be neatly and securely pulled away from the face in a bun or French twist, or a style without loose ends.

MEN: hair should be neatly styled away from the face. Men with long hair should tie it back in a low pony tail.
